## Release Summary

The purpose of this Release Notes document is to provide a brief, educational summary of the items updated or added in this product release.

Release 6.11 is comprised of product updates on email merge fields. We have added two new fields for secondary parents and are hoping to add more in future releases.

Location Selection Page can be generated by adding a special link to the registration URL. On this page, customers can select a location before they see the list of available sessions.

Customers who are enrolled in a payment plan can also enable auto-billing in their online accounts once their payment fails. This will save Organization more time, and allow customers to have a better control over their payment plans.

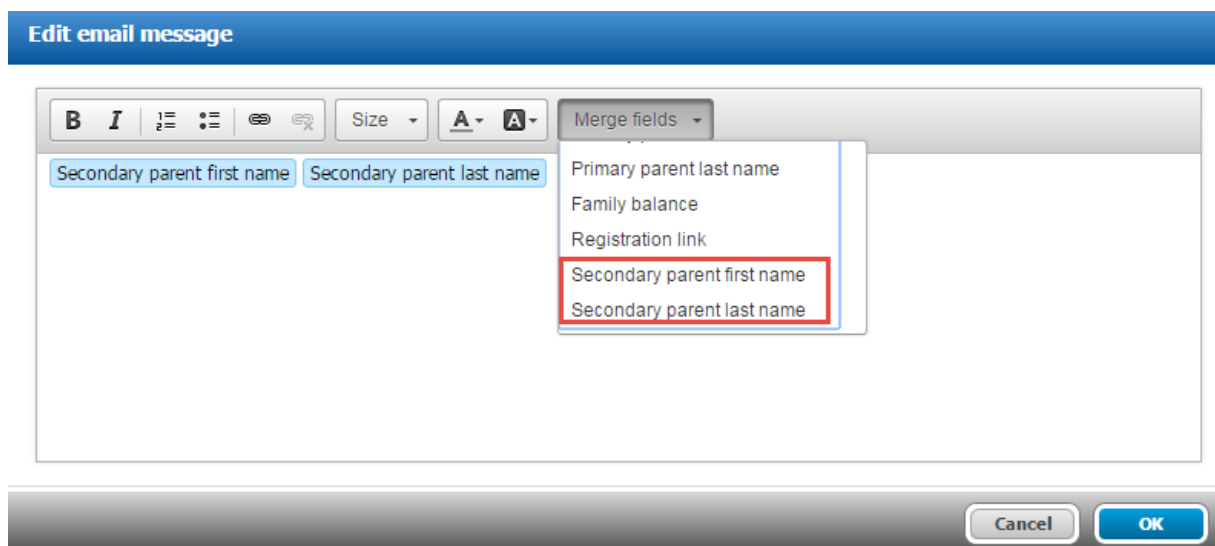
# Enhanced Product Features

## Email Merge Fields for Secondary Parents

Merge fields are used to personalize broadcast emails. In this release, we have added two new merge fields: **Secondary Parent First Name**, and **Secondary Parent Last Name**. Organizations can now address both Primary parents and secondary parents when sending a broadcast email.

### Add Secondary Parent Name Merge Fields to Email

1. In the body of message, place cursor where merge field should go
2. From Merge Fields drop-down, select appropriate field
3. A placeholder for merge field will insert itself into the body of the email
  - **Note:** *When the email is actually sent, each person's name or details will automatically be inserted for every person.*



## Filter by Location on Registration Form

Between Programs and Session Selection Page on Registration Form, a suffix can be added to the registration link to generate a location selection page.

Organization Name

This page comes before the session selection page so that customers can easily find the session in the location they are looking for.

### Select location

## Generate Location Selection

1. From Home Page, Select **Copy registration URL**
2. **Copy** registration link
3. Add **?selectLocation=true** at the end of the URL
4. Once you click **View** next to a specific season, **Select Location** page will appear before **Select Sessions**

## Resume Auto Billing after a Failed Payment

When a payment fails for a customer who is on a payment plan, auto-billing is automatically suspended, and the only way to enable auto-billing was for an Admin user to add them back on from the back end.

Now, customers can log in to their online account to make a partial payment and resume payment plan. This will help customers to better manage their payment plans without having to contact the organization.
