ACTIVE Captivate Portal: Configure sending of notifications on check-in

In the ACTIVE Captivate Portal > **Front Desk** > **Notifications** > **Create a notification** button or (**Drafts/Scheduled** tab > edit a notification) > **Schedule** > **Send on trigger** option, staff users can now select to send the notification:

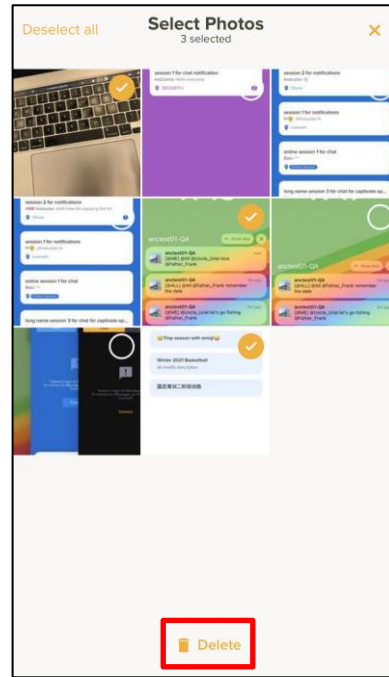
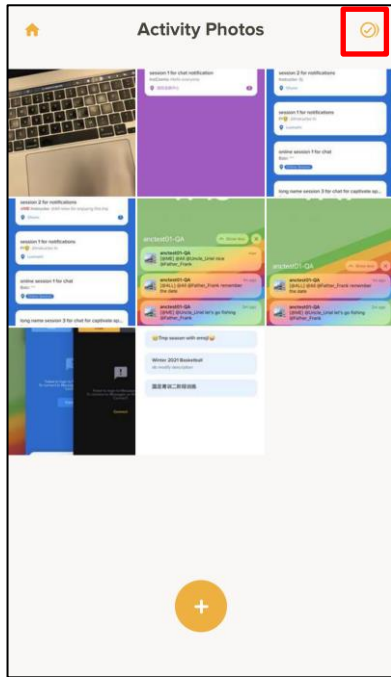


