Enhancements

Sessions tab: display session start and end times

On the season > **Sessions** tab, agency users can now see at a glance each session's start and end times.

- If a session is configured with only a start time, then an end time of 11:59 PM is displayed.
- If a session is configured with only an end time, then a start time of 0:00 AM is displayed.
- If a session is not configured with start and end times, then no times are displayed.

Allow agency users to export sessions



Multi-Factor Enhancements

After users verify their identity by entering their one-time code, they can now instruct Passport to skip 2SV on this device for subsequent log-ins.
