

### Configuring lesson registration cutoff time

Staff users can now configure a time before a lesson starts after which the lesson is no longer displayed to consumers as available for registration in the **Lessons > Create a lesson** button or (a lesson >  icon) > **Registration ends** section:

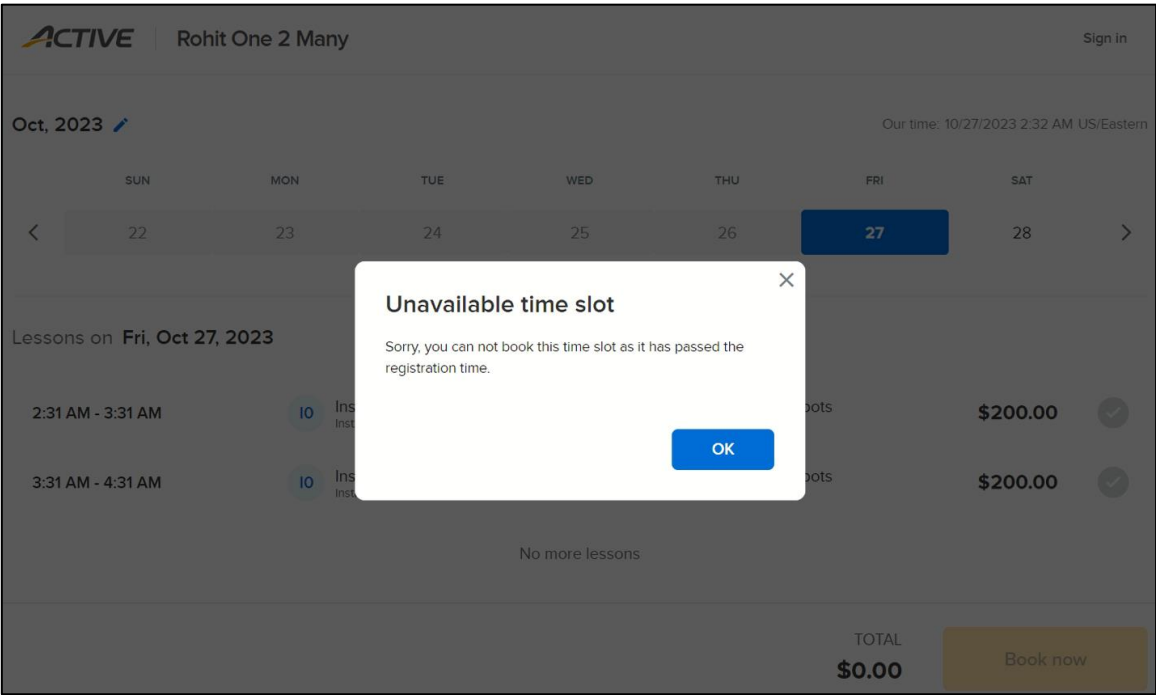
To hide a lesson from registration:
