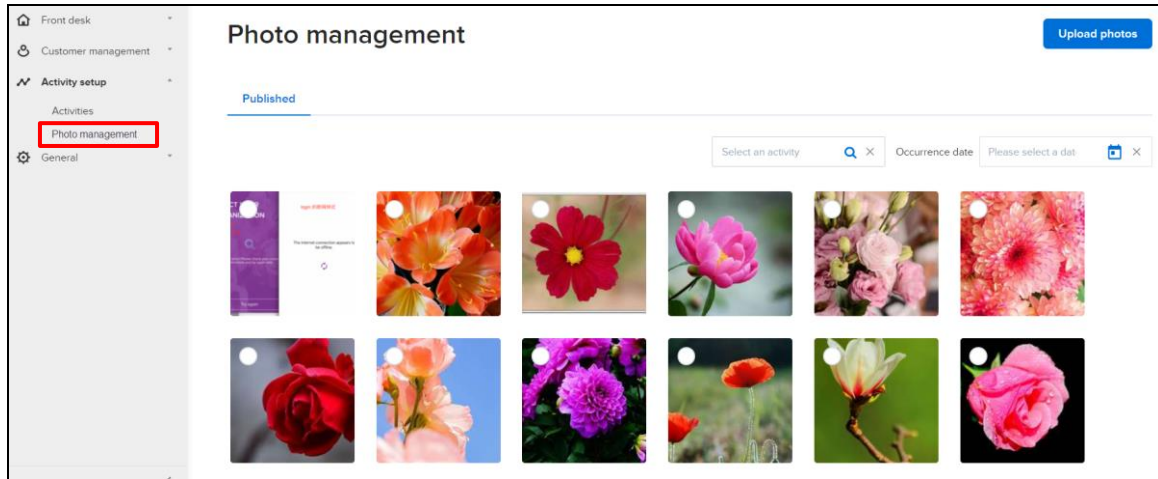

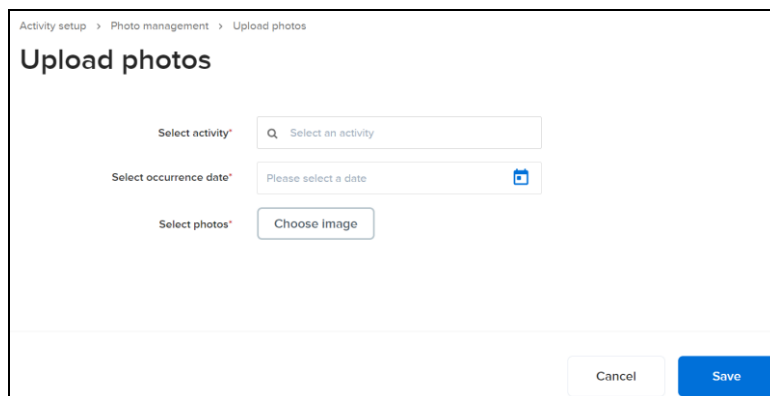
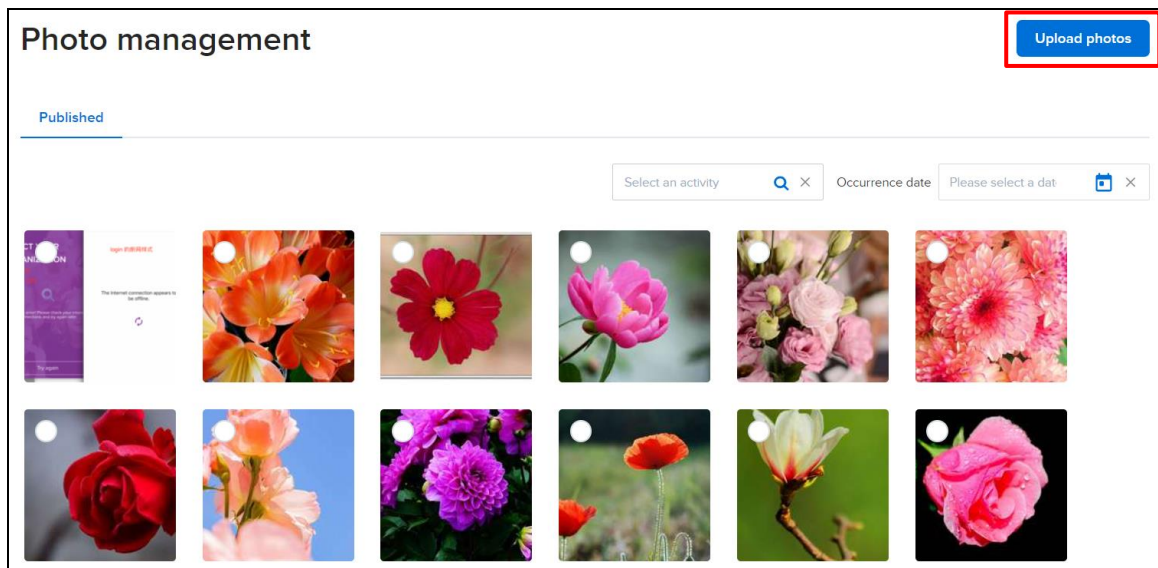
ACTIVE Captivate Portal: photo management

In the ACTIVE Captivate Portal, on the new **Activity setup** > **Photo management** page, agency users can now manage the publishing of photos to the Captivate app:



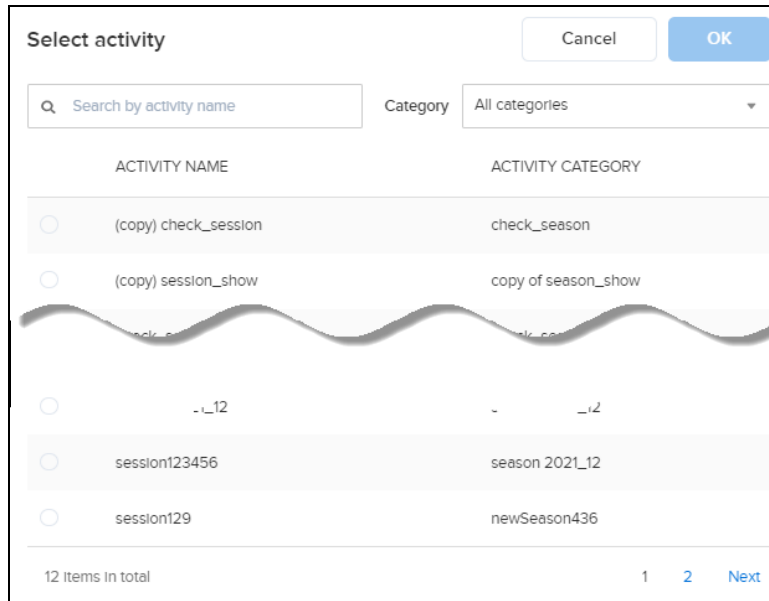
Upload photos

To upload and publish new photos, click the **Upload photos** button and then:

1. Select activity.



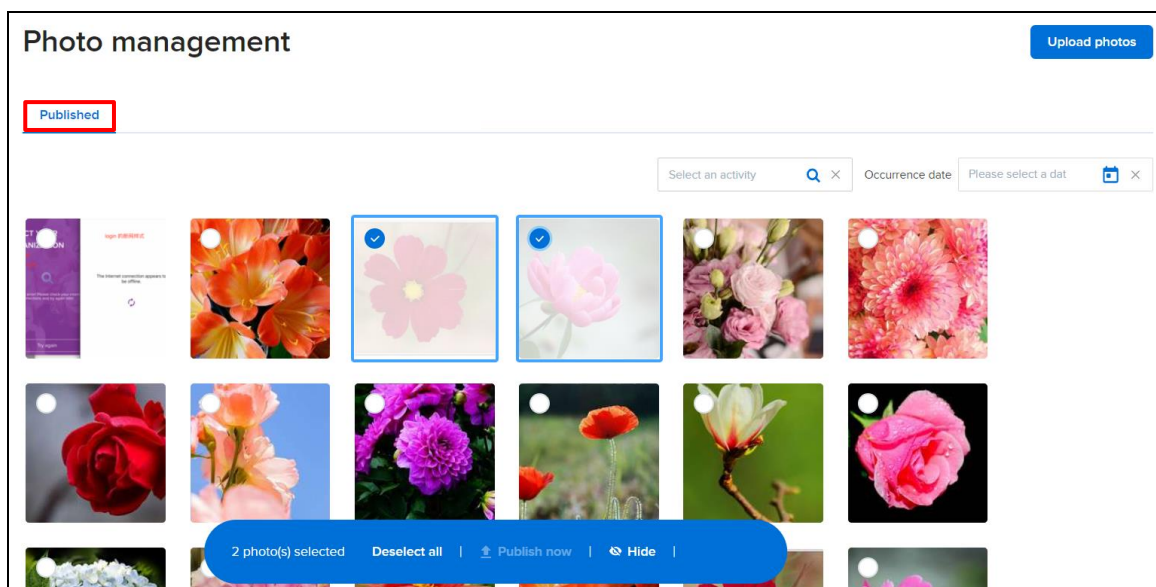
2. Select occurrence date.

3. **Select photos** to upload (maximum 20 photos per upload with a maximum size of 3MB per photo in jpg/jpeg, img or png formats).

4. Click **Save**.

Manage published photos

Photos that have been published to the Captivate app are all listed under the **Published** tab:



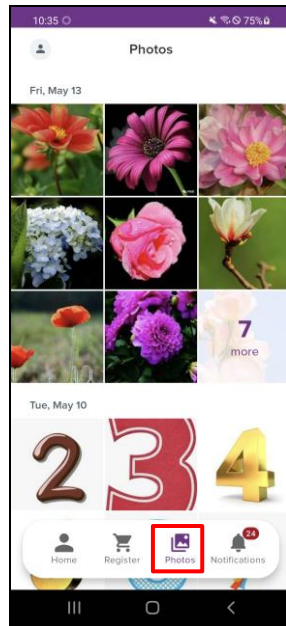
Agency users can:

- View all published photo thumbnails (by default, 60 thumbnails are displayed; to load more thumbnails, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click **More**).
- Filter photos by a session or a season name in the **Select an activity** search box.
- Filter photos by **Occurrence date**.
- Select photos to **Hide** from all app users.

Captivate mobile app: view photos

In the Captivate mobile app, consumers can view photos of sessions in which they are registered by tapping the **Photos** icon:



Photos for all registered seasons or sessions are listed together by date. Users can:

- View more photos on a date by tapping **more**.
- View more dates by scrolling up.
- Tap an individual photo to:
 - View the photo in full size.
 - Share 📷 the photo on social media (Facebook, Twitter etc.).
 - Download ⬇️ the photo.
 - Report 🚫 the photo as inappropriate and hide it immediately from all users.
 - Swipe left or right to view photos before or after this photo.
