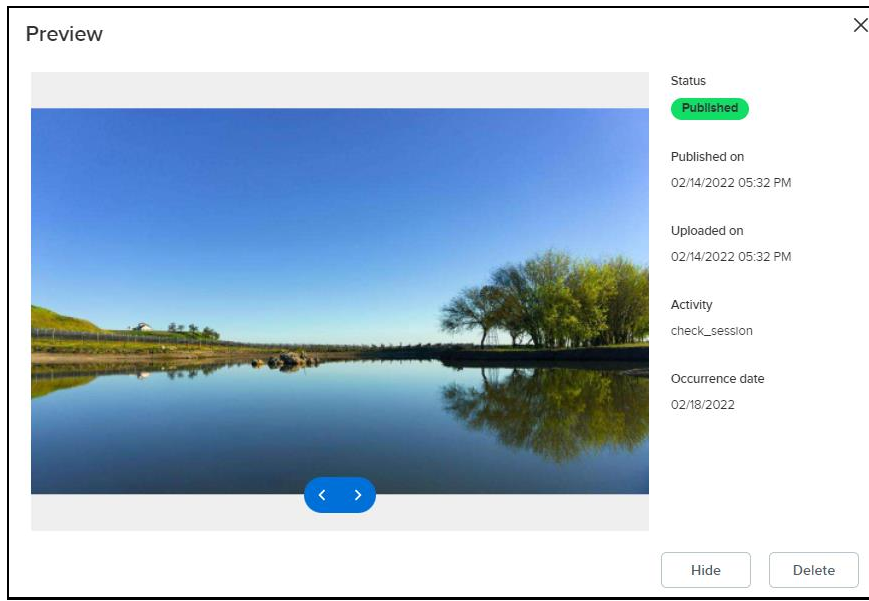
New features

Photo management updates

In this release, the ACTIVE Captivate Portal > **Photo management** function has the following new features:

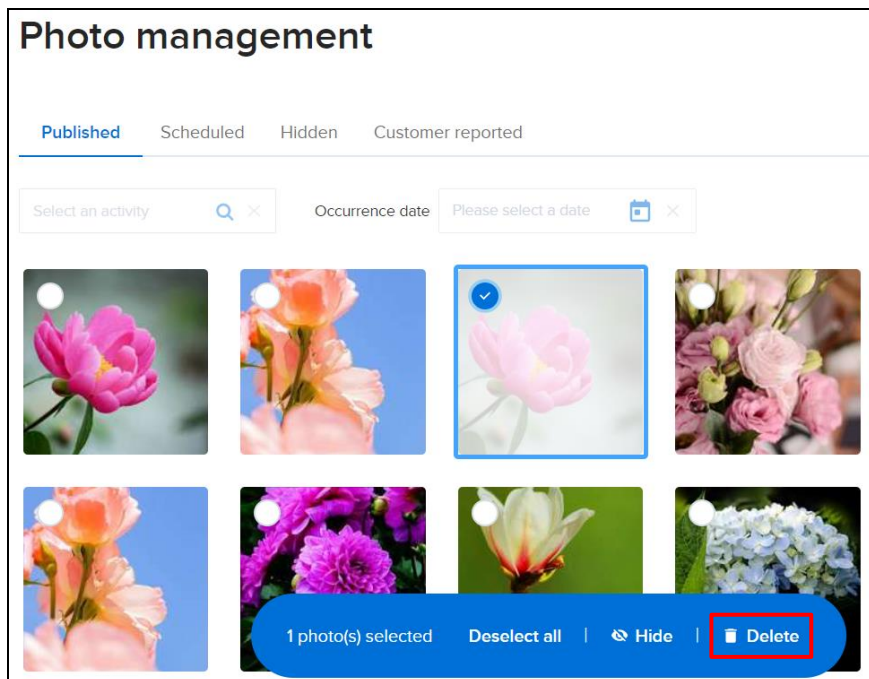
Preview published photos

Agency users can now preview a selected photo in full size with photo's details:



Delete photos

Agency users can now select and delete photos and the deleted photos will no longer appear in the ACTIVE Captivate Portal nor in the ACTIVE Captivate app:

Manage scheduled photos

Photos scheduled to be published to the ACTIVE Captivate app on a future date and time are placed under the new **Scheduled** tab. Agency users can view all scheduled photo thumbnails and select photos to **Publish now** or **Delete**.

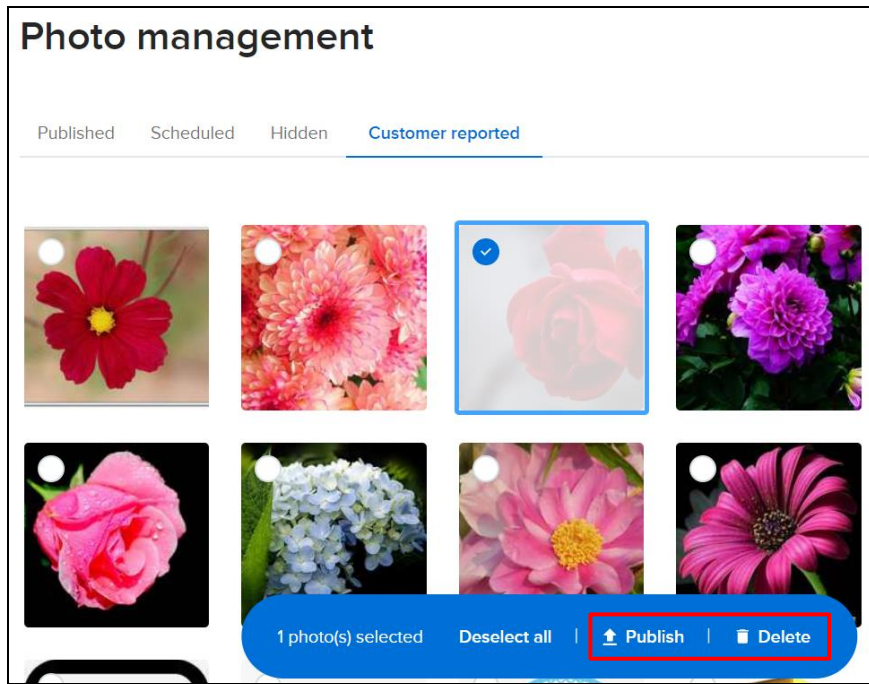

Previously, after an agency changed the ACTIVE Captivate app's splash screen or theme color (on the ACTIVE Captivate Portal > **General** > **Branding** page), consumers had to upgrade their ACTIVE Captivate app to see the new splash screen and theme color.

Now, after an agency changes the ACTIVE Captivate app splash screen or theme color, consumers can see the changes after restarting their ACTIVE Captivate app.
