



Ticketing


ACTIVE Works is no longer just for endurance sporting events; it can now also provide ticketing for **Concert**, **Gala** or **Festival** events.


When you first set up your event, if you select a **Concert**, **Gala** or **Festival** event type, then the registration workflow is automatically configured for ticketing and all endurance-specific fields and pages (such as race distances, sport types, team registration, giving, contact address) are hidden from your customers:



Note: once you have selected and saved the **Event type**, it cannot be changed again between the **Endurance event** and the **Concert/Gala/Festival** options.








When you manage a **Concert/Gala/Festival** type event, endurance-specific features such as the **Teams** tab, **Bib tool**, **Bib numbers**, **Chip numbers**, **Waves**, **Divisions** and **Results** are all hidden.



Bib tool: mixed automatic and manual-import bib assignment

You can now use a mix of both automatic **RULE-BASED** and **MANUAL IMPORT** bib assignment methods in an event to assign bib numbers to participants by their price category.

For example, you can now take advantage of the ease of automatic bib assignments for your mass-market, public price category participants, whilst having full manual control over bibs assigned to your VIP, elite price category athletes.









Just note that if you switch a bib sequence between **RULE-BASED** and **MANUAL IMPORT** or change the bib assignment rule or bib template file, then all existing bib assignments are deleted before the new automatic or manual bib numbers are assigned.

Manual-import bib assignment: upload participants' Division assignments


If you use the **MANUAL IMPORT** tool to assign bib numbers to your participants, then you can now also assign their **Division**s in the uploaded CSV file:








Your uploaded **Division** assignments are displayed in each participant's **Registration information** section and in the **Registrations** report:








Polish language translation
