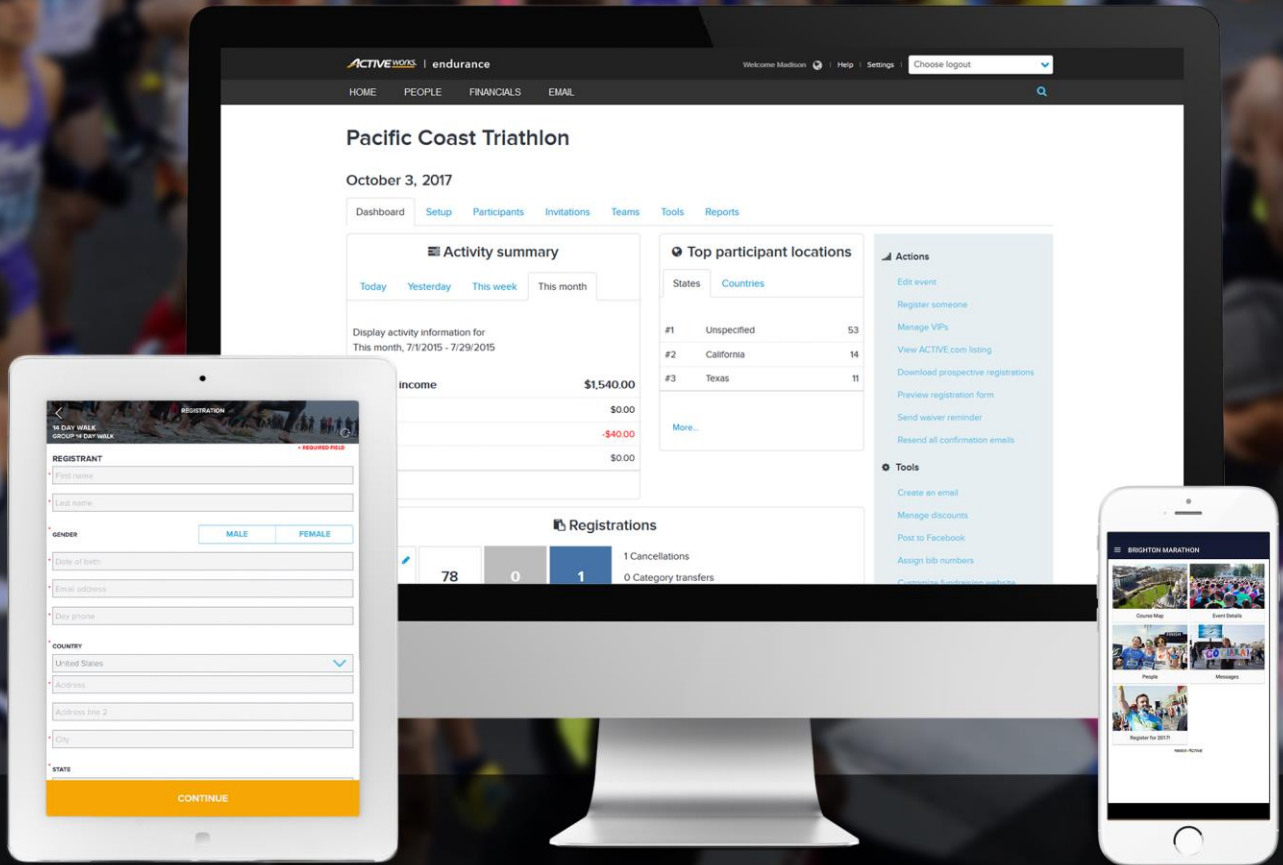


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Multi-Event App

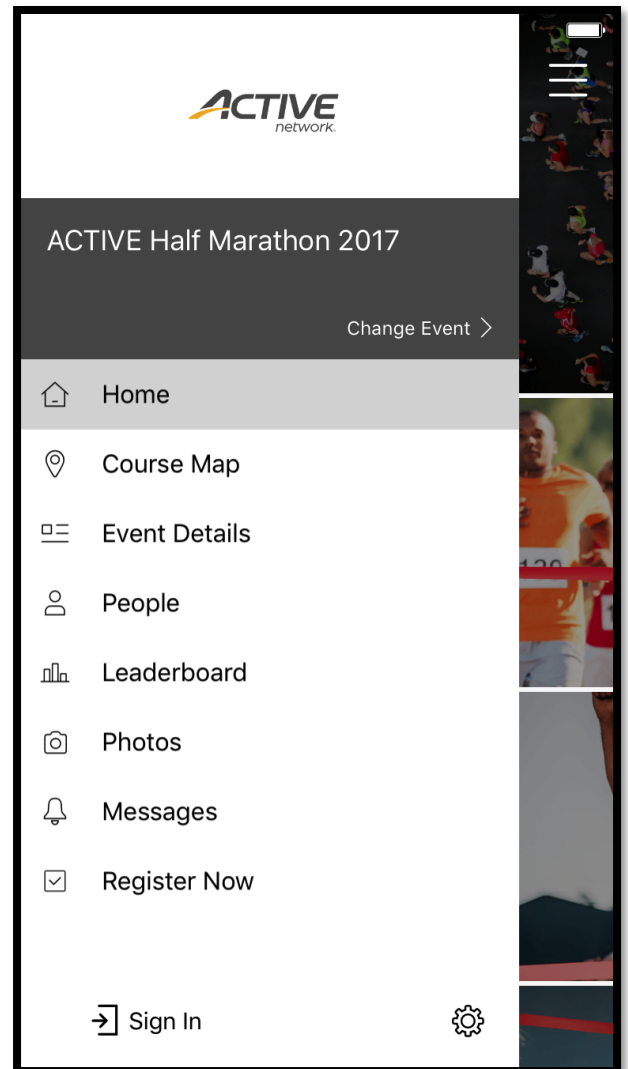
ACTIVE's Event App is a prime tool for engaging spectators, adding value to sponsorships and keeping participants updated. Since its release in the Apple Store and Google Play, the number of app downloads and users have grown continuously. At the same time, many race directors have the need to manage multiple races inside the app.

ACTIVEWorks Endurance now introduces the new Multi-Event App, which allows the management of several events in one ACTIVE Event App. Now, participants and spectators don't need to download different apps for different races. Once organizers group designated races into a Multi-Event App, participants and spectators can download it for free from the Apple Store or Google Play and access all events in the series through a single app.

When opening the Multi-Event App, you can select a desired event within the series and use all functions as provided by the single Event App:

- As an organizer, you can customize the app for your event, send notifications to your app users, and register participants in the app.
- As a spectator, you can track your favorite runners and their progress throughout the race.
- As a runner, you can share your results with your followers through the app, posting on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram.

When the next race starts, participants and spectators just switch to the new race and enjoy the fun within the same app!





Flexible Choices for Volunteer Jobs

Jobs Available to Multiple Groups

Large events have massive volunteer needs that are often filled by groups to support the operations behind the event. In these cases, volunteer coordinators sometimes need large-scope volunteer shifts to be available across multiple groups.

Make it easier to recruit groups to fill larger volunteer shifts by leveraging newly expanded functionality inside ACTIVEWorks Endurance. Allow multiple volunteer groups to register for larger-volume shifts such as early-course water stations, post-finish line chute food distribution, or even gear check. Allowing multiple groups to be able to register for larger-need areas reduces the outreach and management burden on your volunteer coordinators.

Public Volunteer Jobs

In the ACTIVEWorks Endurance volunteer module, volunteer coordinators can now control the availability of a job for public registration. This can be especially important when registering private groups or re-assigning tenured volunteers to key roles.

- If a job is public, volunteers can register for the job via the public registration link.
- If a job is not public, volunteers cannot see or register for the job via the public registration link, but can still register for the job via the group private registration link.

Preferred Language Enhancements

ACTIVEWorks Endurance now supports more languages for volunteer registration. If volunteers select a preferred language on the volunteer registration page, then:

- The next time they visit the page, their selected language is loaded by default
- They will receive registration confirmation emails in their selected language

Fundraising Team Restrictions

Organizers have more options when setting up fundraising team registration for a race. They can now establish fundraising team limits by making fundraising team creation mandatory during registration, requiring registrants to create their own fundraising team instead of joining an existing one.
