




Custom registration report creation: copy an existing report

Many event organizations have multiple events each year that are similar or identical. To save time for athlete services, marketing and operations executives, you can now easily create a custom registration report by copying the format of an existing custom registration report from another event.

In the new event's homepage, simply copy the columns from an existing report by selecting **Reports > Custom Registration Reports > Create > Add and remove columns > Copy columns from an existing report > Select an event > Select a report**


<u>Note</u>: Any column headers in the existing report which are not available in the new event will not be selectable in the new event's report.



Credit balance report: new columns

In the **FINANCIALS** > **Credit balance report** > **Download** > **Detailed report**, you can now view order information for credit balance transactions:





<u>Note</u>: For credit balance transactions which are not related to a registration, no order information is displayed.

In the above example report:

- In row 3, Bob Hamm, \$34.35 from a credit balance was used to pay for a new registration.
- In row 5, Mec Stepten, \$100 was deposited into a credit balance (not related to any registrations, so no order information).
- In row 12, May Yin received \$110 in her credit balance from a registration refund.
- In row 15, May Yin had a deduction of -\$110 from the credit balance report (When you see a negative number with no referenceable order number etc., this indicates that the credit balance has been removed from their account and refunded in a cash transaction against the consumer's original payment method. If you go to the Revenue Report (Ledger), then you will see that this -\$100 is refunded to the original payment method e.g. Credit/Debit Card for May Yin and associated original transaction).

People API updates

The rest/endurance-external-rest-api/agencies/agencyId/people API (which returns a list of the agency's registrants) now supports:


- a null endDate (which defaults to the current date).
- a maximum date range of 1 year to resolve performance issues.

USAT membership update


USA Triathlon (USAT) added new membership categories in January 2022. Active Works Endurance has updated its offering in line with the new USAT membership prices, age groups and agreements/waivers. The options released today are as follows:





Download race pass owners report

You can now download a report of owner's information for a specific race pass (an Elite-tier feature) by clicking the RACE PASS > Race pass tab > name of a race pass > VIEW OWNERS $\stackrel{*}{\Longrightarrow}$ > Download button:



Resolve multi-selection and individual chance entry registration issue

This fixes a bug in an edge case where a purchaser registered multiple participants for individual chance (ballot) entries in a single order, in the case where only some participants were drawn from that single order, there were system faults.



The process has been temporarily updated in the instances of chance (ballot) registration processes to allow only one registration per order. Thus, if a John Smith wants to enter his entire family of 3 in a chance (ballot) category, then John will need to complete 3 separate orders/registrations.

The change seen in the AUI is as follows:

You can no longer configure an event to allow a purchaser to select more than one **Individual chance entry** participant during registration:

- In the AUI Event setup > Restrictions and settings step, if Allow multiple selection on registration
 page option is set to:
 - Yes, then the Individual chance entry option (in the Registration categories step > Price type dropdown) is no longer displayed.
 - No, then the Individual chance entry option (in the Registration categories step > Price type dropdown) is available.
- If an event has an **Individual chance entry** price type, then to allow multiple selection, you must first delete all the **Individual chance entry** price types.
- For existing events with Individual chance entry price types and the Allow multiple selection on registration page option set to Yes, Active will set the Allow multiple selection on registration page option to No in this release.

In a future release we will enable the ability for chance (ballot) entry price types to process more than one registration per order.
